→ SEV has been involved in the VC market for the last 8 years and developed its expertise with a core team of 4 people


IN A SNAPSHOT

- An 8 year old company: activity started in June 2000 with very challenging first 2 years
- A venture organization: the company has been accredited by AMF in 2002 (GP02 024) and manages a €50M Venture Fund (FCPR)
- A highly selective process: SEV reviewed more than 1300 companies in 2008
- A dedicated team: 4 people are working within SEV with 5 to 8 years of experience with additional Venture Partners in China & Japan
- Schneider Electric commitment: a 50 M€ fund financing and a legal structure according to market standards























...through its international deal flow generation in Europe, North America and Asia


→ Schneider Electric Ventures vision is to be a complementary and sustainable support for Innovation within Schneider Electric




Main Corporate bulk competencies



For Schneider Electric, SEV is a scouting & experimentation tool for new technologies and market trends...



- Highlight of new business opportunities through surveys


...to cooperation


